Anesthesia/Surgery Consent Form

I agree to have the above procedure performed at Animal Medical Center of Panola County and to pay for these services. I understand that all precautions will be taken to ensure the well-being of my pet, but with anesthesia and surgery, complications may arise.

1) I understand that my pet will be given an examination prior to anesthesia. I am also aware that a good physical examination does not always reveal abnormalities that can be detected by other methods (e.g. bloodwork). I am also aware that preanesthetic bloodwork is available and is recommended by the staff.

- I accept the staff's recommendation of preanesthetic bloodwork for an additional fee of \$70. There will be a shaved area for blood draws and catheters.
- I decline preanesthetic bloodwork against the staff's advice and realize that this statement is placed in the permanent medical file.

2) Pain management is also available for our patients. This is strongly recommended as research now indicates that patients with less pain have faster healing times.

- I accept the staff's recommendation for pain management for an additional fee.
- I decline pain management against the staff's advice and realize this statement is placed in the permanent medical file.

3) All surgical procedures can be performed using a *CO2 Laser* unit which decreases bleeding, decreases pain, and enhances healing by decreasing tissue damage.

- I prefer the surgical procedure be performed using the *CO2 Laser* unit for an additional \$55.00 which includes the *Therapy Laser* at no additional charge.
- I decline laser surgery for my pet.

4) All surgical procedures can be treated with a *Therapy Laser* which allows your pet to heal faster after surgery. This laser allows relief of pain through the release of endorphins and stimulates the injured cells to heal at a faster rate.

- I prefer the *Therapy Laser* be performed after surgery for an additional \$20.00.
- I decline *Therapy Laser* for my pet.

5) Microchips can easily be placed while a pet is under anesthesia. The fee for this service is \$36.00

- I would like a microchip placed during anesthesia
- I decline the microchip for my pet.

In accordance with state and county law, all animals 4 months old and older are required to be current on Rabies vaccination. If the vaccination is not current, one will be administered. Other core vaccines such as Distemper - Parvo and Bordetella are required while in the hospital for all patients' protection against these deadly diseases.
